ZOOM WEBINAR INFORMATION

The Annual Meeting will be presented
virtually through Zoom Webinar. Once you
have registered, we will send along the
Zoom webinar information.

For Zoom webinar, you will need to have
access to the internet and a computer to
participate. You won't be able to participate
by telephone only. To fully participate by
computer only, your computer needs to
have a microphone and speakers. If your
computer does not have a microphone
or speakers, you will need to use your
telephone to hear the presentation while
watching it on your computer.

In order to minimize our expenses, the
registration brochure will be emailed to
members and others. It will also be posted
on the website when ready. We are only
mailing to those members who requested
mailings.

SILENT AUCTION
